- Awakening to God.
- Unity Among the Churches, Government, Businesses.
- Bind the Spirits of Poverty, Division, Racism, & Religion.
- Awakening to Come to the City.
- For the Ambassadors of Christ to Arise.
- Influence & Favor.

5. PRAY FOR THE CIVIL GOVERNMENT

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercessions and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority.

1 Timothy 2:1–2

CIVIL GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINTS

- That they would execute justice.
- That they would govern with wisdom for the “welfare of the city” (Jer. 29:7).
- That God would accomplish His purposes through them regardless of their willingness to be used by Him (Proverbs 21:1).
- That they would follow the Lord’s ways and repent if they don’t.
- Their health and safety.

6. PRAY FOR YOUR FRIENDS

And the Lord restored the fortunes of Job, when he had prayed for his friends. And the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before.

Job 42:10

FRIENDSHIP PRAYER POINTS

- Pray that according to the riches of God's glory, He may grant your friend to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in her inner being, so that Christ may dwell in her heart through faith (Ephesians 3:16–19).
- Pray that the God of endurance and encouragement would grant you and your friend to live in harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 15:5–6).
- Beg the Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and God your Father, who loved you and gave you eternal comfort and good hope through grace, to comfort your friend's heart and establish it in every good work and word (2 Thessalonians 2:16–17)
- Implore the Lord not to let steadfast love and faithfulness forsake your friend, but that he would bind them around his neck and write them on the tablet of his heart. Remind God of His Word, which teaches that doing this will bring your friend favor and good success in the sight of God and man. Pray that he would trust in the Lord with all his heart, and not lean on his own understanding. Ask that in all his ways he would acknowledge God and make straight your friend's path. Entreat the Lord to help your friend not be wise in his own eyes, but to fear the Lord, and turn away from evil. Claim God's promise that this will result in healing to your friend's flesh and refreshment to his bones (Proverbs 3:3–8).

7. PRAY FOR YOUR WORKPLACE

Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.
